

THOUGHTS FROM FR. COYNE

Friends,

How blessed am I to have had the privilege to serve at St. Lucy & St. Monica parishes during the past 3 months. MISSION VISIT/SECOND COLLECTION

Fr. Bernard Makadani Zulu from The Society for the Propagation of the Faith will be preaching at all our masses **this weekend**. We will be taking up a **second collection** for the needs of the people of the Diocese of Chipata.

The Diocese of Chipata is appealing for financial support to provide food relief and water to affected communities after the severe drought that Zambia experienced in the 2023/2024 rainy season. This was the driest agricultural season in over 40 years, resulting in significant crop losses, increased livestock deaths, shortage of water, and worsening poverty for many families.

The rainy season was characterized by late onset, prolonged dry spells, and high temperatures. The erratic rainfall affected crop and animal production; many families depend heavily on rain fed farming. These dry conditions resulted in massive reduction in crop production, with maize (corn) production, which is a staple food, declining drastically.

Shortage of food due to depleting stocks, and increasing commodity prices will increase the risk of malnutrition among the affected communities. The food shortages and rising prices for the staple food will hinder vulnerable peoples' access to food, especially in rural areas where the poverty levels remain high.

We ask for your support to mitigate the impact of the severe drought and build resilience within our communities to emerge stronger. Your sacrifice and immeasurable generosity will serve and protect the lives of many people in Chipata Diocese.

FIRST READING

Joshua 24: 1-2a, 15-17, 18b

Joshua gathered together all the tribes of Israel at Shechem, summoning their elders, their leaders, their judges, and their officers. When they stood in ranks before God, Joshua addressed all the people: "If it does not please you to serve the LORD, decide today whom you will serve, the gods your fathers served beyond the River or the gods of the Amorites in whose country you are now dwelling. As for me and my household, we will serve the LORD."

But the people answered, "Far be it from us to forsake the LORD for the service of other gods. For it was the LORD, our God, who brought us and our fathers up out of the land of Egypt, out of a state of slavery. He performed those great miracles before our very eyes and protected us along our entire journey and among the peoples through whom we passed. Therefore we also will serve the LORD, for he is our God."

RESPONSORIAL PSALM

I will bless the LORD at all times; his praise shall be ever in my mouth. Let my soul glory in the LORD; the lowly will hear me and be glad.

As the church is subordinate to Christ, so wives should be subordinate to their husbands in everything. Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ loved the church and handed himself over for her to sanctify her, cleansing her by the bath of water with the word, that he might present to himself the church in splendor, without spot or wrinkle or any such thing, that she might be holy and without blemish. So also husbands should love their wives as their own bodies. He who loves his wife loves himself. For no one hates his own flesh but rather nourishes and cherishes it, even as Christ does the church, because we are members of his body. *For this reason a man shall leave his father and his mother and be joined to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh.* This is a great mystery, but I speak in reference to Christ and the church.


PRAYER TO ST. MICHAEL






