Where is the newborn King of the Jews?

While the people of Jerusalem submitted to the power of a tyrant king (King Herod), and they served him because he had rebuilt the Temple of Jerusalem; Another king, the King of Kings, is born in Bethlehem and is adored by the Wise Man. The Jews thought that with Herod their people and religion would have prosperity and that is why they submit to human power, but they do not know that Herod uses them. He rebuilt the temple not because he cared about the Jews and their religion, but because he wanted to show his power, he wanted to make the Roman Empire see that he was capable of building larger and more beautiful temples than those that were in Rome itself.

The people of Jerusalem had forgotten that God does not manifest Himself through temporal power, they had abandoned the true God and had forgotten the Scriptures; they only cared about the temporary goods, and in this numbness, they do not realize Herod's true intentions. They live a few miles from Bethlehem, but they are unable to set out to worship the God made flesh.

But there were some who following God's revelation through creation were looking for the real King. These men – the wise men, make a long journey to offer their gifts to Jesus; they do it with all the inconveniences of that time and without the certainty of the exact place where to find the King of Kings, but they set off.

Dear parishioners: our lives are also in danger of seeking only for earthly power and falling asleep in a faith without devotion, without fervor, and without true adoration of God. All this happens when our religiosity has become only a habit, it happens when we do not share the Good News to those who are around us, it takes place when we do not go to meet Christ in the poor and needy or when we don't set aside time to celebrate our faith in liturgical celebrations.

Definitely, we are not or do not want to be like Herod, a selfish person who wants to be in power at all costs; but neither can we be like those people who have stopped believing in God by clinging to what is only earthly. We must be, instead, like the wise men who set out on their way and look for the King until they find him; it does not matter if sometimes we lose our path as the Magi did, Christ will always come out to meet us through the light of his Word to return us to the right path; it does not matter if others do not move and do what corresponds to them, we must be like wise men and offer now our life, time and talents to our King, our Lord Jesus Christ.





They were overjoyed at seeing the star, and on entering the house they saw the child with Mary his mother. They prostrated themselves and did him homage. Then they opened their treasures and offered him gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh. And having been warned in a dream not to return to Herod, they departed for their country by another way.
