

Friends,

On behalf of myself and the staff at St. Lucy & St. Monica Parishes, I want to wish all of our parishioners, neighbors and friends a wonderful 4th of July. I tell people all the time that I am so happy that I grew up in this country and our church when I did. We have experienced and witnessed major changes in our lifetime and especially in recent years in both our nation and our Church. In my childhood, next to the influence of my family, it was the country and the Church that played major roles in assisting me as I developed a value system that enabled me to make positive choices and healthy decisions. Of course, in those days we believed that anyone in authority had to be right and we accepted their direction as if it was God's will. Today, we ask a lot more questions including how did those in authority get into that position? Is everything just black and white or is there room for gray? What is the background of the person in authority? What influences play a role in his/her life? We have access to so much more information today. So, for example, after we see our doctor and get a diagnosis, we seek out a second opinion. Or, if we don't appreciate the message we hear at our local parish, we give ourselves permission to seek out another priest who may look at life differently.

On the week of Independence Day, I am so grateful for the freedoms we have. The state does not tell us what to believe, we have the right to free speech, we have freedom to protest government decisions. Obviously, there is a lot of controversy that surrounds these freedoms e.g., I may not believe that white supremacists should be able to hold public rallies, but our Constitution grants them that right. I lived through the civil rights marches and the Vietnam War and yet I don't believe our country has ever been more divided than we are today. "They" say you can't mix politics and religion and the Church and state have to remain separate. I understand the threat that is posed if one was to dominate the other. Yet, on the other hand, I have to admit that my Christian beliefs deeply affect my political leanings. I cannot separate my faith from how I vote.


The 1960's were very turbulent years in the life of America. They were very painful years for many. Looking back on these years, I now see them as growing pains which resulted in many of the freedoms we experience today. Everyone would not agree.

In the Catholic Church, the Second Vatican Council is also a product of the 60's (1962-65). Those same freedoms that became realities in the country also demanded to be celebrated in our Church. I am a very strong advocate of the Second Vatican Council and therefore am as proud this week to be a citizen of the Church as I am to be a citizen of this country.


May God bless America and may God bless every other country in this world.



Dear Families,

As you may know, Cardinal Séan O'Malley has *lowered the age of reception of the Sacrament of Confirmation to Eighth Grade* in the Archdiocese of Boston. This decision is based on recommendations from members of local Churches, and the desire to strengthen the relationship of our young people with Christ and his Church, opening to them the grace of the sacrament. For more information about these changes, please visit https://www.evangelizeboston.com/confirmation/

The Archdiocese has permitted each parish community to determine how to implement this change. After learning what other parishes are doing and much internal discussion, *the Parishes of St. Lucy and St. Monica will make this transition to an Eighth-Grade Preparation over the next three years, while simultaneously strengthening our current high school youth ministry programs.*

What does this mean right now for those interested in preparing to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation?

- Our Confirmation Preparation Program will become a 1-year program starting this year;
- This coming September, 2024 we will prepare <u>both 9th and 10th Grade</u> students for reception of the Sacrament of Confirmation;
- Next September, 2025 we will prepare <u>both 8th and 9th Grade</u> students for reception of the Sacrament of Confirmation;

I will provide more details in the coming weeks as we move forward together in this transition toward an Eighth-Grade Confirmation Program. In the meanwhile, I ask you to spread the word about this change to as many families inside and outside our parish communities as you can. Feel free to share it on social media and direct people to our website for more information and to register.

Youth Ministry

At the same time, we are excited to strengthen the Youth Ministry in our parishes. Youth Ministry at St. Lucy and St. Monica's will empower our youth to minister to their peers, their Church, and the community by providing regular service opportunities, social events, and worship events. In addition, we are looking into ways we can partner with area high schools and other Church organizations. I look forward to engaging with you about this program and welcome input as we shape this ministry. Feel free to call me at the office and stay tuned for more information on both our Confirmation and Youth Ministry Programs..


