

They say that a priest's life is not his own, which the Lord reminded me of in no uncertain terms last fall. For all of us, everyday belongs to Him even if we forget, but I got a direct reminder of the truth of that fact with the extra lease on life. So when I am asked how I feel about changing assignments, I answer that I am sad to leave Methuen, only cautiously optimistic about moving, and it kind of goes with the direction of this year in general.

I will miss our Collaborative very much, particularly the daily interactions with people of faith, the school kids and their families, as well as staff and volunteers. We have had a very eventful six years together. It's amazing to look back on the status of the collaborative and facilities at my arrival, the great upset of Covid, and the many projects of renewal that we have undertaken to improve our community. I am proud of what we have accomplished together to put St. Monica Parish, St. Monica School, and St. Lucy Parish on a better footing for the future.

More work needs to be done, of course, and is always needed, which is why being a pastor sometimes feels like being in a relay race: receiving a baton, giving your best effort, and then handing it off to the next runner. My prayer is that after this summer of transition, a new pastor with a different set of skills will be able to improve other aspects of our community (like ministry volunteerism) to help the collaborative flourish. I ask you to pray for that intention, too, and for me.

It will be difficult to move away from such beautiful spaces and reverent devotion and just as difficult to settle into different surroundings. I guess to look at it more positively: it means ready made projects to undertake in a new location! I suppose the timing is right, though, as I alluded to above. Six years is the length of an official assignment, actually, and this last year has been very eventful for me personally, so being asked to take on a simpler assignment (on paper, anyway) is not all that unexpected. I am very sorry to say a farewell of sorts, but like to keep in mind that a 20 minute drive is not that far at all for anyone who wants to stop by and say Hi. Let us continue to pray for one another in our future life of faith and may God bless you all.

Memorial Day serves as so much more than the unofficial start of summer. Memorial Day is set aside for Americans to honor the men and women who died while serving in the U.S. military. Originally known as Decoration Day, it originated following the Civil War, which claimed the lives of more Americans than any other conflict in our history. Every family, every community felt the war and so following its conclusion--as early as the late 1860s--communities and towns throughout the United States began holding springtime tributes to the fallen soldiers of the war, decorating their graves with flowers and reciting prayers. While it is unclear exactly where the first celebrations were held, in 1966 the United States government declared Waterloo, NY the birthplace of Memorial Day. In 1968, Congress passed the Uniform Monday Holiday Act, which established Memorial Day as the last Monday in May in order to create a three-day weekend for federal employees. The change went into effect in 1971. The same law also declared Memorial Day a federal holiday. This weekend, when you gather with family and friends, please remember our fallen soldiers and turn to God in prayer for their souls and in gratitude for the sacrifice they made for us to have freedom.






