

Last week we celebrated the Baptism of Our Lord. I mentioned in my homily that the Church gives prominence to three preeminent manifestations of our Lord:

- 1. The Epiphany, when the three Magi visited the newly born Christ Child in the manger. A manifestation of "a Light to the nations."
- 2. The Baptism of our Lord, when Jesus rose out of the water with the Holy Spirit hovering over Him in the form of a dove and the Father's voice was heard from Heaven, "You are my beloved Son, with you I am well pleased." A manifestation of the Holy Trinity.
- 3. The miracle at the wedding feast in Cana, when Jesus not only lavishly turned the water in sex stone water jars into wine ("holding 20-30 gallons"), but also made it into s superior wine. A manifestation of Jesus' two natures human and divine.

These 3 manifestations reveal the extraordinary generosity of God.

Another way that God reveals His generosity and bestows mercy is through indulgences. The Code of Canon Law, Canon 992 states, "An indulgence is a remission before God of the temporal punishment for sin the guilt of which is already forgiven, which a properly disposed member of the Christian faithful obtains under certain and definite conditions with the help of the Church which, as the minister of redemption, dispenses and applies authoritatively the treasury of the satisfactions of Christ and the saints."

Canon 993 states, "An indulgence is partial or plenary in as far as it frees from the temporal punishment due to sin either partly or totally."

Canon 994 states, "The faithful can gain partial or plenary indulgences for themselves or apply them for the dead by way of suffrage."

Traditionally the Church celebrates a Jubilee Year every 25 years. Pope Francis declared this Jubilee Year 2025 as "Pilgrims of Hope," and an opportunity to gain indulgences.

To gain indulgences one must confess mortal and venial sins, receive Holy communion, pray for the Pope's intentions, and participate in one of the following activities:

- * Participate in a mission, some spiritual exercise, or study the catechism or a Vatican II document.
- * Perform spiritual or corporal works of mercy
- * Take on a penitential practice
- * Or, visit a Jubilee site. Here's a list of sites established in our Archdiocese:



Now there were six stone water jars there for Jewish ceremonial washings, each holding twenty to thirty gallons. Jesus told them, "Fill the jars with water."

So they filled them to the brim. Then he told them, "Draw some out now and take it to the headwaiter." So they took it. And when the headwaiter tasted the water that had become wine, without knowing where it came from — although the servers who had drawn the water knew — the headwaiter called the bridegroom and said to him, "Everyone serves good wine first, and then when people have drunk freely, an inferior one; but you have kept the good wine until now." Jesus did this as the beginning of his signs at Cana in Galilee and so revealed his glory, and his disciples began to believe in him.
