Second Sunday of Easter

"Do not be afraid.

I am the first and the last, the one who lives.

Once I was dead, but now I am alive forever and ever."

(Revelations 1:18)





In 2005 a small group of men and women of St. Monica Parish initiated the celebration of Divine Mercy Sunday in our parishes with a Holy Hour at 3 o'clock in the afternoon, the hour of Divine Mercy. I was a newly ordained deacon then, just getting to know those men and women, but many times over these years I have thought of them as men Jesus would have turned to in Galilee and said, "Come, follow me," and women who would have followed him from Galilee to Golgotha. They have faithfully spread the message of Divine Mercy and prayed the Divine Mercy Chaplet for the Sick and the Dying for many of our parishioners.

Divine Mercy Sunday of 2005 was a very special Sunday. In October 2004 Pope St. John Paul II had inaugurated the Year of the Eucharist, dedicating an entire year to the Blessed Sacrament, inviting the entire Church to reflect upon the Eucharist. It would close in October of 2005.

On April 2, 2005 St. John Paul, after 26 years as the Bishop of Rome, died at 9:37 p.m., within the Vigil of Divine Mercy Sunday and within the Octave of Easter. Easter Sunday and Divine Mercy Sunday were exactly at the center of the Year of the Eucharist. Our God who has unfathomable love for humanity and such respect for human history helped us to see the unity and centrality of the Eucharist, the Resurrection and Divine Mercy in that Easter Octave of 2005. Our God who is love, mercy and communion itself shared all of it with St. John Paul.

In 1981 St. John Paul had said, "Right from the beginning of my ministry in St. Peter's See in Rome, I considered this message of Divine Mercy my special task... as my special task before God."

The message of Divine Mercy had its beginnings during the 1930s when Jesus began to appear to Helena Kowalska, a young religious sister in Poland now known as St. Faustina (1905-1938). In a series of revelations Jesus asked her to be his secretary and apostle of

mercy. St. Faustina kept a diary in which she wrote that Jesus said, "My daughter, say that I am love and mercy personified."

Fr. Seraphim Michalenko (1930-2021), a priest of the Marians of the Immaculate Conception, who was the vice-postulator for the cause of canonization for St. Faustina and the director of the National Shrine of Divine Mercy in Stockbridge, Massachusetts wrote, "The mission God gave St. Faustina was not only to remind the world of the great mercy of God revealed in Sacred Scripture, but also to teach us new forms of devotion to the Divine Mercy and initiate a movement of apostles of Divine Mercy who show a childlike trust in God and love of neighbor." The Novena to Divine Mercy and the Chaplet of Mercy, two of the new forms of devotion to the Divine Mercy, are taken from the *Diary of Saint Maria Faustina Kowalska*.

St. John Paul understood Jesus' revelation to St. Faustina as a prophetic revelation. In 1993 St. John Paul beatified St. Faustina in Poland, and on April 30, 2000 in St. Peter's Square he canonized her as the first saint for the new millennium, and he established the Octave of Easter for the universal Church with the special title Divine Mercy Sunday.

On the day after St. John Paul's death apostles of Divine Mercy in St. Monica Parish, showing a childlike trust in God and love of neighbor, began the tradition of celebrating Divine Mercy Sunday here in Methuen.

Pope St. John Paul II, pray for us. St. Faustina, pray for us. Jesus, I trust in you







SECOND READING

Rev 1: 9-11a, 12-13, 17-19

I, John, your brother, who share with you the distress, the kingdom, and the endurance we have in Jesus, found myself on the island called Patmos because I proclaimed God's word and gave testimony to Jesus. I was caught up in spirit on the Lord's day and heard behind me a voice as loud as a trumpet, which said, "Write on a scroll what you see." Then I turned to see whose voice it was that spoke to me, and when I turned, I saw seven gold lampstands and in the midst of the lampstands one like a son of man, wearing an ankle-length robe, with a gold sash around his chest. When I caught sight of him, I fell down at his feet as though dead. He touched me with his right hand and said, "Do not be afraid. I am the first and the last, the one who lives. Once I was dead, but now I am alive forever and ever. I hold the keys to death and the netherworld. Write down, therefore, what you have seen, and what is happening, and what will happen afterwards."

On the evening of that first day of the week, when the doors were locked, where the disciples were, for fear of the Jews, Jesus came and stood in their midst and said to them, "Peace be with you." When he had said this, he showed them his hands and his side. The disciples rejoiced when they saw the Lord. Jesus said to them again, "Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I send you." And when he had said this, he breathed on them and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit. Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them, and whose sins you retain are retained." Then he said to Thomas, "Put your finger here and see my hands, and bring your hand and put it into my side, and do not be unbelieving, but believe." Thomas answered and said to him, "My Lord and my God!" Jesus said to him, "Have you come to believe because you have seen me." Blessed are those who have not seen and have believed." Now Jesus did many other signs in the presence of his disciples that are not written in this book. But these are written that you may come to believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that through this belief you may have life in his name.




