

#### **Dear Parishioners**

These past two weeks have been weeks of some news for the Archdiocese of Boston and our parishes in particular. Two weeks ago, we received the news that His Holiness Pope Francis has appointed His Excellency Bishop Richard G. Henning S.T.D., as the new Archbishop of Boston. We welcome our new Archbishop with great joy and we pray to God to bless him at all times. A week ago, my assignment as Administrator of St. Monica and St. Lucy's Parishes was also announced. When the clergy personnel told me that this was my new assignment, I received it with great joy, knowing that it is God who guides his Church. I pray to God for all of you whom He entrusts me to serve as a priest, and I also pray for myself, that He may help me to be a good instrument in His hands. Please remember me in your prayers.

I am sure that we will have time to get to know each other, grow in fraternal love, and enrich each other with the gifts that God has given us, but so that you have an idea of who I am, allow me to tell you a few things about myself. I am Father Marcos T. Peña Portillo, born and raised in El Salvador. I come from a large family, we are seven siblings and our parents are: Santiago Peña and Maria E. Portillo de Peña. In 2009 I was ordained as priest for the Archdiocese of San Salvador, but on April 5<sup>th</sup> of this year I was incardinated in the Archdiocese of Boston, since I have been living in Massachusetts for a little over four years. The last two months I have been parochial vicar of Saint Peter Parish in Cambridge, but from February 2020 to June 2024 I was parochial vicar of All Saints Parish in Haverhill, where I enjoyed my last four years of priestly ministry.

Now God has entrusted me with a new task, much more demanding than the previous one. I trust that God will give me the wisdom to be a good shepherd, I am sure that all of you will help me with my new task because of your love for God and your community, and I promise that I will do my best to live up to my new assignment.

May God bless our parishes of St. Monica and St. Lucy, and may He help us to bring His message of love to all those He has placed at our side.

# MISSION VISIT/SECOND COLLECTION

Fr. Bernard Makadani Zulu from The Society for the Propagation of the Faith will be preaching at all our masses on the weekend of **August 24th and 25th.** We will be taking up a **second collection** for the needs of the people of the Diocese of Chipata.

The Diocese of Chipata is appealing for financial support to provide food relief and water to affected communities after the severe drought that Zambia experienced in the 2023/2024 rainy season. This was the driest agricultural season in over 40 years, resulting in significant crop losses, increased livestock deaths, shortage of water, and worsening poverty for many families.

The rainy season was characterized by late onset, prolonged dry spells, and high temperatures. The erratic rainfall affected crop and animal production; many families depend heavily on rain fed farming. These dry conditions resulted in massive reduction in crop production, with maize (corn) production, which is a staple food, declining drastically.

Shortage of food due to depleting stocks, and increasing commodity prices will increase the risk of malnutrition among the affected communities. The food shortages and rising prices for the staple food will hinder vulnerable peoples' access to food, especially in rural areas where the poverty levels remain high.

We ask for your support to mitigate the impact of the severe drought and build resilience within our communities to emerge stronger. Your sacrifice and immeasurable generosity will serve and protect the lives of many people in Chipata Diocese.
