This week we celebrated the Exaltation of the Cross. Of course, it is difficult to exalt the Cross because it is perhaps the most horrendous form of capital punishment that mankind ever conceived. The Cross is God's plan for the salvation of mankind from all eternity. The Cross is God's manifestation of the love that is the very nature of God. God is love and God is unchanging. God loves us with the love of Jesus on Calvary from all eternity. God walks with us in the difficult moments; we are not alone. God doesn't stop loving us when we fall. Rather, God seeks us like a hound from Heaven, drawing us back to His mercy in the Sacraments, especially Holy Confession and Holy Eucharist.

Psalm 23 reassures us that no matter what we experience, we are not alone: "Even though I walk in the dark valley I fear no evil; for you are at my side with your rod and your staff that give me courage." What is that dark valley? The sufferings we experience, the stuff that happens to us sometimes at random, sometimes by our own cause, sometimes by someone's innocent intent, and sometimes because someone has bad intent. The dark valley is ultimately when our bodies fall asleep for the last time and our souls are liberated. It is the hope we need that Jesus will be with us, the Good Shepherd who leads us, with rod and staff, with the Cross, that gives us hope, that gives us strength, across the dark valley of death to the restful shores of eternal life in God.

God the Father, from all eternity, gives this hope to us through the life and saving work of Jesus. On the night before Jesus suffered Calvary, He said, "I am troubled now. Yet, what should I say? 'Father, save me from this hour?' But it was for this purpose that I came to this hour." Jesus was born for one purpose. He was born to die. His Passion and Death on the Cross liberate us from the slavery of sin. Free will is God's gift and we can misuse it. We do fall in sin and sin wounds our souls. His wounds heal our wounds. Our sin separates us from God, especially Mortal Sin that destroys God's sanctifying grace in us. When we seek reconciliation, God heals the separation with the merits of His Passion and Death. In this way, God maintains our option to seek Him freely, especially when we have fallen in sin and need His mercy. God's mercy is deeper and wider than we can imagine. All we need to do is seek that mercy especially in the Sacraments of the Church. God's mercy is inexhaustible because it is of God.

God joins His Divinity to the humanity of the Blessed Virgin Mary. He lowers Himself to become a human person and offers His humanity to save all humanity. But before He makes that offering on Calvary, He also lowers Himself further by promising to be with us always in the Most Blessed Eucharist. "This is My Body. This is My Blood." In other words, this is Me, your loving God, with you from all eternity and with you always to the end of the age. Jesus is in the Eucharist, really, truly, and substantially, Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity, in a morsel of consecrated wheat, in a drop of consecrated wine.

God offers His Divine eternal life to us. "My Flesh is true food. My Blood is true drink." If you eat my Flesh and drink my Blood, you have the secret of Eternal Life in you. We do exalt the Holy Cross because God offers God to God, from the Last Supper, from the Altar of the Cross on Calvary, from the Altar at every Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. Jesus offers His Body and Blood to our Heavenly Father for us, to give us hope, to give us strength.
