"A man fell victim to robbers as he went down from Jerusalem to Jericho. They stripped and beat him and went off leaving him half-dead. A priest happened to be going down that road, but when he saw him, he passed by on the opposite side. But a Samaritan traveler who came upon him was moved with compassion at the sight." - Lk 10:30b-31, 33

On the gift of Sacred Silence, before, after, and during Holy Mass on Sundays and weekdays:

The following reflection is not directed in any way at parents who have young children who add to our prayer and praise in unpredictable yet nonetheless glorious ways!

"Then the LORD said: 'Go out and stand on the mountain before the LORD; the LORD will pass by.' There was a strong and violent wind rending the mountains and crushing rocks before the LORD—but the LORD was not in the wind; after the wind, an earthquake—but the LORD was not in the earthquake; after the earthquake, fire—but the LORD was not in the fire; after the fire, a light silent sound. When he heard this, Elijah hid his face in his cloak and went out and stood at the entrance of the cave. A voice said to him, 'Why are you here, Elijah?'" (1Kings 19:11-13)

The 2002 General Instruction of the Roman Missal (GIRM) speaks very specifically about silence before and during the liturgy. We read: "Sacred silence also, as part of the celebration, is to be observed at the designated times. Its purpose, however, depends on the time it occurs in each part of the celebration. Thus within the Act of Penitence and again after the invitation to pray, all recollect themselves; but at the conclusion of a reading or a homily, all meditate briefly on what they have heard; then after Communion, they praise and pray to God in their hearts." There should also be silence before the liturgy: "Even before the celebration itself, it is commendable that silence be observed in the church, in the sacristy, in the vesting room, and in adjacent areas, so that all may dispose themselves to carry out the sacred action in a devout and fitting manner."

To this we would add that silence should also be observed before and after Mass until one is outside the Church building, both for respect toward the Blessed Sacrament, and toward those members of the faithful who wish to prolong their thanksgiving after Mass. Our modern world is starved of silence and Holy Mass should be a privileged moment to escape the hustle and bustle of daily life and, through worship and participation in Christ's eternal sacrifice, become capable of giving an eternal value to these same daily and transitory activities. To help achieve this, we encourage the spirit of attentive and active silence in our celebrations and refrain from importing the world's clamor and clatter into their midst.

It is important to reiterate that the above reflection pertains to adult conversations that usually can occur outside of sacred space. Parents are highly encouraged to bring children to church regardless of any fussing made in spite of their best efforts otherwise. In short, we love the extra music! Pray, pray, pray! Those who sing pray twice! Pray, hope, and don't worry!

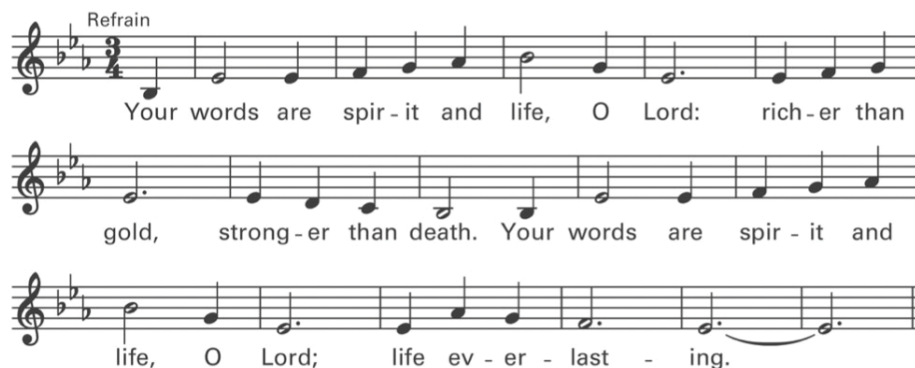


