Through religious education, prayer services, retreats, and outreach programs, students are encouraged to deepen their relationship with God and live out the Gospel values in their daily lives. Our fifth-grade class has been visiting with the residents at **Methuen Village** since the new year. Twice a month students engage with residents to chat, play games, read a story, share a snack and even dance. The relationships fostered are priceless. Our students look forward to their short walk to see the genuine excitement in the residents' eyes.

Our art teacher, Mrs. Lisa Buglione, has collaborated with **Nevins Library** by connecting children's literature to art. Once a month a librarian visits a grade level and Mrs. Buglione follows up with a related art project. In fact, we held our annual art show in Nevins Library in April. What a treat it was to see an original piece of work from each of my 270 students on display!

For the second year in a row, our second graders are the special guests of **Methuen's Office of Veterans Services** at their annual Flag Replacement. They will be singing their hearts out and replacing the flags to honor Veterans' contribution to our freedom and our nation.

Our collaboration with the **Methuen Music Hal**l has brought a new dimension to our drama program. Our students have the experience of presenting at this beautiful, prestigious theater and appreciating this historical site. This year's show *Finding Nemo Jr* was a huge hit! Each year our production grows, we had over fifty students participate in this production!

Ultimately, as you can see by the few examples listed above-collaboration and evangelization work hand in hand to nurture a vibrant and faith-filled educational environment. By uniting in purpose and sharing the Good News with others, our Catholic school community not only strengthens its own bonds but also serves as a catalyst for positive change in society. Through collaborative efforts rooted in faith, individuals are empowered to make a meaningful difference in the world, embodying the values of love, justice, and service championed by Catholic teachings. In this way, community collaboration and evangelization become powerful vehicles for fostering spiritual growth, cultivating a sense of belonging, and inspiring lives of purpose and compassion within the Catholic school community and beyond.
