Fortunately, just as Jesus sent out His disciples in pairs, so do the "Vincentians" of our St. Monica-St. Lucy's parish. They meet the needs of neighbors (in their homes) who are seeking relief within our parish boundaries. There are no "summer vacations" from this "Vincentian" vocation as evidenced by the reporting of neighbors who "Vincentians" compassionately served in many capacities from mid-July through mid-August 2023.

We served 70 Adults–41 Children with 120 Bags of food plus expenditures of \$3,144.85 for: Market Basket Cards – Target Cards - Gas Cards – Auto Insurance, Auto Repairs, Electric Bills, Rental support, Clothing Vouchers, Bedding, Diabetic food items, and more.

Without the generosity and compassion of you, the parishioners of this parish, the effort might not be limited, but the results would. On behalf of our neighbors who struggle to eat a couple of healthy meals a week and worry about getting through each day with a sense of identity and dignity, we thank you for your prayers and contributions of time, talent, and treasure. God Bless you and all who surround you.

### Saints Michael, Gabriel and Raphael, Archangels

#### FEAST DAY: SEPTEMBER 29

These archangels, messengers sent by God, are the only ones named in the Bible. In the Book of Daniel, Michael is called "the great prince'; in the Letter of Jude, he argues with the devil over Moses' body; and in the Book of Revelation, he leads the battle against Satan. He is patron of the sick, radiologists and mariners. Gabriel explains Daniel's visions to him in the Book of Daniel, and in the Gospel of Luke announces to Zechariah and Mary the births of their respective sons. He is the patron of messengers and telecommunications and postal workers. Raphael guides Tobiah in the Book of Tobit; he is patron of the blind, physicians and travelers. The church created their joint feast after the Second Vatican Council.



#### **GOSPEL ACCLAMATION**

**GOSPEL** Jesus told his disciples this parable: "The kingdom of heaven is like a landowner who went out at dawn to hire laborers for his vinevard. Going about nine o'clock, the landowner saw others standing idle in the marketplace, and he said to them, 'You too go into my vineyard, and I will give you what is just.' So they went off. And he went out again around noon, and around three o'clock, and did likewise. Going out about five o'clock, the landowner found others standing around, and said to them, 'Why do you stand here idle all day?' They answered, 'Because no one has hired us.' He said to them, 'You too go into my vineyard.' When it was evening the owner of the vineyard said to his foreman, 'Summon the laborers and give them their pay, beginning with the last and ending with the first.' 




