

"Who do you say that I am?" A pivotal question in our life.

If I went out this upcoming winter to go pond skating with some friends and told them I was a world class skater, my inability to lace my skates would belie my words. If I told Fr. Marcos that before I became a priest I had previously worked as a chef at a high-end restaurant, but couldn't crack an egg, he would rightly call me a liar. I just might not be who I say I am when I tell you I can play eight musical instruments but don't know the difference between the brass, woodwind, or percussion sections of a band. However, everything that Jesus did and everything that Jesus said proved who He is - "the Christ, the Son of Man, the Messiah, the only Begotten Son of God." Everything He said and did manifested the reality of who He is - Jesus Christ, True God & True Man, the Christ!

On the way to Caesarea Philippi, St. Peter did acknowledge Jesus as the Christ, but later on in the Garden of Gethsemane and in the courtyard outside the trial, St. Peter's words and actions betrayed his claim of being a disciple of Jesus. He ran from the Cross, the Sacrifice, the discomfort. But years later as Pope, he proved his faith by laying down his life for Christ and for the sake of the Gospel.

Do my actions, my thoughts, my words, betray who I think Jesus is, and who I claim to be - a Christian? Do I betray my Christian character and betray and deny Christ by settling for human respect and human rewards and a life of ease? Rather than instructing the ignorant, admonishing the sinner, bearing wrongs patiently, forgiving offenses, counseling the doubtful...taking up my cross? As St. Peter worked as "the slave of the blacks forever" in Columbia, dressing, feeding, consoling, caring and catechizing them, he wrote in a letter, "This is how we spoke to them, not with words, but with our hands & our actions."

This weekend the Catholic Church traditionally celebrates both the Exaltation of the Holy Cross and also Our Lady of Sorrows. With Mary, Our Lady of Sorrows by our side, we will not run from the Cross.

Who is Christ for me? A man of history, a wise prophet, a man to be shunned and kept at a distance? Or, is He my friend, my help, my brother, my Lord and God, the Christ? In every waking moment we answer that question through all our actions and all our words; in what we do and in what we fail to do.

Pope St. John Paul II said, "In our case also, in order to make a more conscious profession of faith in Jesus Christ, we must, like Peter, listen attentively and carefully. We must follow in the school of the first disciples, who had become His witnesses and our teachers. At the same time we must accept the experience and testimony of no less than twenty centuries of history marked by the Master's question and enriched by the immense chorus of responses of the faithful of all times and places."

Let's remember to go to Our Lady for encouragement. She was the ultimate disciple who would *hear the word of God and do it*. (Luke 8: 21, cf Mark 3: 35). She is the model for all Jesus' disciples...for all peoples. May the intercession of all the saints before us, and the example of all the saints among us, help us all to gladly deny ourselves, courageously take up our cross, and faithfully follow wherever Jesus leads.



FIRST READING

Isaiah 50: 4c-9a

So also faith of itself, if it does not have works, is dead.

Indeed someone might say, "You have faith and I have works." Demonstrate your faith to me without works, and I will demonstrate my faith to you from my works.

GOSPEL *Mark 8: 27-35*

Jesus and his disciples set out for the villages of Caesarea Philippi. Along the way he asked his disciples, "Who do people say that I am!" They said in reply, "John the Baptist, others Elijah, still others one of the prophets." And he asked them, "But who do you say that I am!" Peter said to him in reply, "You are the Christ." Then he warned them not to tell anyone about him.

He began to teach them that the Son of Man must suffer greatly and be rejected by the elders, the chief priests, and the scribes, and be killed, and rise after three days. He spoke this openly. Then Peter took him aside and began to rebuke him. At this he turned around and, looking at his disciples, rebuked Peter and said, "Get behind me, Satan. You are thinking not as God does, but as human beings do."

He summoned the crowd with his disciples and said to them, "Whoever wishes to come after me must deny himself, take up his cross, and follow me. For whoever wishes to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for my sake and that of the gospel will save it."


