



FROM FR. BILL

Sr. Suzanne Fondini, MFIC- A tremendous gift to St. Monica School and the Church

A couple of weeks ago I wrote a column about staffing changes. One big one that I could not share with you then, but has now been announced, is the retirement of Sr. Suzanne Fondini, our beloved principal, which will take place at the end of this academic year. Sister recently celebrated her 50th anniversary in religious life. Though she remains very youthful and spry, she has been serving for many years and has earned a well-deserved retirement from the grind of leading a school. She won't retire from being a religious of course, but she will be able to slow down quite a bit, which is fitting and proper.

She is now finishing her sixth year as our principal and in that time has overseen so many great changes in the school. She has brought a wonderful Franciscan charism as the spirit of the school is imbued with an integrated Catholic spirit, a love of the poor and the environment. Like the Good Shepherd she knows each one of the students by name. During her years here so many good things have happened. The New England Association of Schools and Colleges awarded us their accreditation, a detailed Strategic Plan was written and implemented, many improvements were made in the area of technology, the pre-school was opened resulting in a 15% growth in student enrollment, tremendous improvements were made to the security of the school building so sadly necessary in our time, and a new office space was created for the principal and secretary making the school much more welcoming to parents and visitors.

As a new pastor, I could not have been more blessed to work with Sister. I have enjoyed tremendously learning about Catholic education from such a holy, kind and generous woman. Very soon a search committee will be formed to assist in selecting her successor and it is our hope to have a new principal named by early February allowing time for smooth transition. Please during these months take the time to thank Sister when you see her for the tremendous love that she has shown to our school and all of its students, faculty and staff. I have always joked with her that if I could snap my fingers and make her 30 years old again I would sign her to a 40 year contract. Her shoes will be huge ones to fill, may we pray that the Holy Spirit will send the right person to fill this important position. ⁶




