You may find it unusual to think that the manner in which we run our Religious Ed classes or offer Mass for the students of St. Monica School could affect so many other events in our calendar, even on a different day, but it's true. In COVID world, everything produces a ripple effect. That's because the time and effort it takes to prepare for, run, and cleanup up after any event has many safety protocols. It's never just as easy as adding an event to the calendar or asking for more volunteers to help. Any change affects several aspects of what needs to be done for other events and who is available to make it work. And that's if everything goes as planned.

Of course, that's never the case. To the contrary, the staff is routinely talking about what future calendar events we can hold to enhance parish life, only to have the Church, State, or Methuen COVID code throw a monkey wrench into what we can or cannot do. This makes planning very difficult and requires almost a month-to-month. even week-to-week mindset. Another way things don't go as planned is when something outside of our expectations happens: someone informs us that they've tested positive for COVID-19 or a larger than expected number of people show up for an event. These circumstances require on the ground decisions or a contingency plan, but not a major change in how we operate.

As we do our best to keep our parishioners and visitors safe during these unprecedented times, we continue to ask for your patience and charity with all of the staff, volunteers, and each other. When something unexpected occurs, we thank you for finding ways to charitably and patiently work together to resolve any negative ripple effects that result. Stay safe and God bless!
