Over time and in so many other areas of parish life, we will continue to do the best we can to honor the Lord and strengthen the Body of Christ right in our midst.



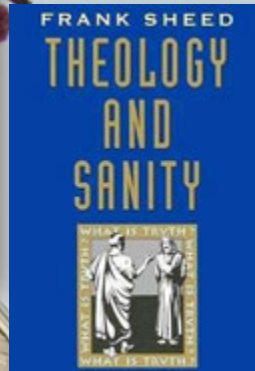
