






5 week video presentation by Fr. John Riccardo



The "Catholic Appeal"- An important collection bearing the proper name

As Catholics we know that sometimes difficult periods in our history are great opportunities for reform, a time to take a step back and look with fresh eyes and renewed perspective at what we do as a Church and how we do it. In the wake of the difficult revelations of the abuse of minors by clergy and other representatives of the Church, the Church both locally and throughout America made many important changes to protect our children. One small name change in Boston that occurred in the years following the scandal breaking was just a symbolic one but rich in meaning.

Years ago the annual archdiocesan appeal to support the central ministries of the Archdiocese was called the "Cardinal's Appeal." The title referred to the fact that this appeal is made directly to the people by the Cardinal himself, to support the works of the Church done under his leadership. No doubt it bore that name as a way to appeal to people's loyalty to their institutional church, expressed in the person of the Cardinal Archbishop. It is no secret that in the years following the 2002 revelations contributions to that appeal dropped significantly. Out of a sense of frustration and anger at what had come to light, many withheld much of their money as a form of protest. Though parish offertory also declined, it did not do so to the same degree as the collection for central ministries.

The change in the name form the "Cardinal's Appeal" to the "Catholic Appeal" was a very good one, because the Archbishop as important as he is to our life as an Archdiocese, is not the Church. He is the local shepherd, but he is only one man. He is not a politician, a mayor or a congressman. He is a shepherd of a local community of believers. The word "Catholic" has several meanings, it means "universal"; "open to all"; and "complete." It is a powerful word that reminds us that we are connected to one another, we are open to all and are indeed our "brother's keeper."

It is important that we remember that we have an obligation to Catholics in need that are serviced by the varied ministries that are carried out in our central ministries. I know in my absence you heard/saw a beautiful video from Cardinal Sean highlighting some of those important ministries. This year we are substantially behind in our collection for the Catholic Appeal, it is my sincere hope that through your generosity we can make up the difference. It is also important that you know that if we fall short of our goal the Archdiocese mandates that the difference be taken from our operating funds, so either way they get the money in the end and our parishes will suffer if we don't give. If we meet our goal it sends a strong message to the Archdiocese that we are generous parishes that care about others. In the recent past we received abatements for parts of our shortfall, but there is no guarantee we will receive those in the future. Remember that St Paul reminds us that "God loves a cheerful giver" and we should give in love, not out of a sense of obligation. We must overcome our hurts and disappointments and realize that it makes no sense to hurt those in need because of our anger over our painful history. The blue cards are in the pews again this weekend. Please fill them out and drop them in the basket or send them to the parish office. BE SURE TO WRITE YOUR PARISH NAME prominently on your check and on the blue envelope. Thanks for your generosity to this appeal.
