
#### **Blessed Virgin Mary Sodality**

"For this reason a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh. So they are no longer two, but one flesh. Therefore, what God has joined together, no human being must separate." - *Matthew 19:4-6* 



This Sunday is the third Sunday before Ash Wednesday, which was referred to as Septuagesima Sunday for many centuries prior to the liturgical reforms of 1969. The two and a half weeks before the beginning of Lent allowed the faithful to prepare for the season of fasting without it being thrust upon them suddenly on Ash Wednesday.


It is important to remember that the season of Lent used to be a true fast. The norm for fasting up until the mid-1960's was to eat just one meal per day, with complete abstinence from flesh meat, fats, and broths made from warm blooded animals. This applied every day of the week except Sunday. In practice, these regulations were relaxed almost everywhere, but Lent was definitely a season that people felt in their bodies.

Today, we are only required to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, and to abstain from meat on all of the Lenten Fridays. The requirements are really quite mild, so the tradition of giving something up for Lent takes on a greater importance. If you have noticed the bulletin boards in our churches, you may have seen a poster that reads, "Don't give up chocolate for Lent." The idea is that Lent is meant to be a time of the year when we discipline ourselves so that we can respond to God's will more promptly and joyfully.

It could be that someone could give up chocolate, and this would lead to greater love of God and neighbor, but, for most, a little more thought is needed. Every individual should pray about their sacrifice. No one should undertake anything too austere without seeking spiritual advice. Sometimes, people will give up sinful habits for Lent, only to take them back up after Easter. The time to give up sin is always now. For Lent, we should sacrifice something that is good, for the sake of preparing for greater blessing from God.

Let's pray for each other that we will use this time before Lent to discern well the way that God is calling us to become holier this Lent!
